

CLINICAL SKILLS LABORATORY

Clinical Skills Laboratory is developed like a state of the art operation theatre with advanced audio-visual system to do any medical or surgical procedure (operation) on cadaver for the development of both procedural skills and the conceptual understanding of gross anatomy. The laboratory is readily converted to provide a setting similar to an operating room. It provides an excellent opportunity to learn difficult procedures for the postgraduate trainees and consultants in medical and surgical faculty. This enables surgeons and their assistants to assess new techniques in a safe environment. The laboratory is linked by audiovisual cable to the auditorium and classrooms to provide demonstrations to larger audiences. It also has facility (deep refrigerators) to preserve cadavers for prolonged period.



Clinical Skills Laboratory consists of: Main procedure area, dissection halls, classroom and cadaver preservation unit and is equipped with-

- Full array of surgical instrumentation for anatomical dissection
- State-of-the-art videoconferencing facility
- High Definition Cameras in lab to allow the classroom participants to watch live system.
- Capable of recording videos for use as instructional videos, or as presentation media to view surgical techniques suitable for submission to national or international meetings.
- Fresh non embalmed cadavers for more realistic tissue handling
